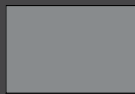

Blue | June-August

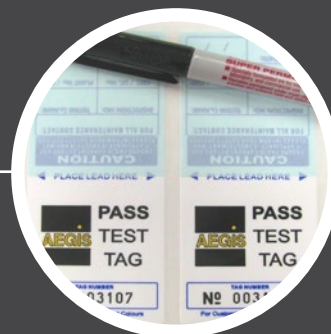
Burgundy | 5 year schedule
